Tentative Itinerary

DAY 1 - USA

Gather at US airport and board your trans-Atlantic flight to Vilnius. Enjoy meals and snacks en route and arrive the next afternoon with a grand time of sightseeing, touring, fun and activities ahead.

DAY 2 – Kaunas

Welcome to Vilnius, Lithuania! Upon arrival in Vilnius you will be met by your tour guide before transferring to Kaunas, Lithuania. You will be taken on a quick tour of the city of Kaunas. We will visit the remarkable Old Town which is a collection of ancient architectural monuments: the remnants of the 14th century with remains of Kaunas castle, the buildings of the Middle-Ages in the Gothic and the Art Déco styles. After your tour you will then proceed to your sleeping accommodations for the rest of the night to relax, get settled and explore the surrounding area.



DAY 3 - Kaunas

After breakfast, you will have a light practice followed by a clinic that you will run for a basketball team from Kaunas Sports School. After the clinic, we will visit the 9th Fort, a stronghold built in 19th century that has a tremendous historical significance during the periods of Lithuania's occupation by the Soviet Union and the Nazi Germany. After the tour, we will head back to the hotel and you will have another opportunity to explore the Old Town of Kaunas and enjoy the evening in the heart of the city.

DAY 4 - Riga

After an early breakfast, we will depart for a day trip to Riga, capital of Latvia. Situated on the banks of river Daugava, Riga has a lot to offer. Architecture of Riga is beauteous and diverse. Heritage of 800 years old Gothic churches, built by founders of Riga, medieval buildings in the Old Town, exquisite Art Noveau, as well as wooden buildings make Riga a true pearl of architecture. Funky and vibrant, Riga is a metropolis with a bigcity atmosphere hard to find elsewhere in the region.



Tentative Itinerary

DAY 5 - Palanga

After an early breakfast, we will depart the hotel in Kaunas permanently and will travel to the hottest tourist destination in the summertime – the city of Palanga on the shore of the Baltic Sea. On the way, we will stop at one of the most prominent Lithuanian monuments and tourist attractions, Hill of Crosses, where we will spend 1-2 hours touring. We will arrive in Palanga in early afternoon and will get settled into our new hotel. We will then travel about 30 mins to Klaipeda, the third biggest city in Lithuania. The city is notable for its Germanic flavor and architecture that reflects its fascinating past as Prussian capital Memel. The city was destroyed in WWII, during which it served



as a Nazi submarine base, but a teeny weeny patch of its Old Town survived unscathed.

DAY 6 - Palanga

After breakfast you will be free to enjoy the entire day at this vibrant party beach resort of Palanga. Tourists from all over Lithuania and abroad flock to its idyllic 10km sandy beach backed by sand dunes and scented pines. The resort is full of restaurants, bars and hotels, which are always busy with people. Yet despite the crowds and encroaching neon Palanga retains its traditional charm with wooden houses and the ting-a-ling of bicycle bells and pedal-powered taxis adding a quaint air to red-brick Basanavičius Street - the pedestrian heart of the action.

DAY 7 - Vilnius

After breakfast we will depart for the capital – Vilnius, where we will spend our last two nights of the trip. On the way, we will stop in Trakai to visit its red-brick fairy-tale castle. It is the only insular castle in Eastern Europe. Sights of Trakai are representing Lithuanian culture and history, where nature and architecture harmonically supplement each other. After touring the castle, we will continue our trip to Vilnius where we will settle into our new hotel and will have the opportunity to experience the capital's nightlife.
